The purpose of the party patrols are to deter under age alcohol and drug use violations through plain clothes patrol on the University of Idaho Campus. Every year, new students come to the University of Idaho and have little or no understanding about the level of danger involving under age alcohol use. For the last several years MPD has utilized plain clothes officers to patrol during peak Greek party weekends with good effect. The tactic had a hand reducing the rate of violations on subsequent party weekends. A reduction in underage drinking violations and medical calls for intoxication was observed by officers. Word of mouth that officers are in plain clothing, enforcing open container and under age drinking violations in the campus Greek system, has been a powerful tool to facilitate compliance. Our party patrols directed toward alcohol enforcement in the past have led MPD to marijuana and other drug seizures, citations, and arrests.

Project Description

In May of 2022, the Moscow Police Department obtained a Narcotics detection canine, K9 Ragnar. K9 Ragnar can be used during a series of organized patrols aimed specifically for drug interdiction traffic stops. K9 Ragnar and his handler will team up with another patrol officer to work as a cover officer while K9 Ragnar and the handler can focus on vehicle sniffs. Two other officers will conduct traffic stops on Highway 95. The two patrol officers will advise if there are observed indicators or suspicion of trafficking and or drug possession with a ten-code status before requesting to check driver and vehicle status with dispatch. Our narcotics detective will also advise if there are person's or vehicles of interest in the area through their resources.
