Narrative

THIS IS AN ONLINE REPORT FILED FROM IP ADDRESS [REDACTED].Unwarranted invasion

THE FOLLOWING IS THE DESCRIPTION ENTERED BY CITIZEN:

I WAS GETTING MY HAIR DONE BY CHRISTINA LUCK AT LOFT SALON ON AUGUST 4, 2020. MY APPOINTMENT WAS AT 1 PM. I ARRIVED AT MY APPOINTMENT WITH A GREY BACKPACK THAT HAD \$1200 IN IT. THIS IS THE TIP MONEY I MADE OVER SUMMER AT MY JOB AS A BARISTA. UPON RETURNING TO COLLEGE I WAS PLANNING ON DEPOSITING THE MONEY INTO MY BANK ACCOUNT. AFTER MY APPOINTMENT WAS OVER, I PAID WITH MY CARD AND ACCIDENTALLY FORGOT MY BACKPACK AT THE SALON. I DID NOT REALIZE RIGHT AWAY I FORGOT MY BACKPACK. I WENT OUT TO A FRIEND'S LAKE CABIN AND ONCE I WAS THERE I REALIZED MY BACKPACK WAS NOT IN MY VEHICLE. I QUICKLY CONTACTED THE OWNER OF THE SALON, CHRISTINA LUCK, WHO WAS THE WOMAN WHO DUD MY HAIR. I ASKED IF I HAD LEFT MY BACKPACK THERE AND GOT NO REPLY. I QUICKLY CALLED MY BOYFRIEND WHO LIVES CLOSE TO THE SALON AND ASKED HIM IF HE COULD GO LOOK AT THE SALON BECAUSE I WAS 45 MINUTES OF OUT TOWN AT THIS POINT. HE WENT TO THE SALON AND SURE ENOUGH MY BACKPACK WAS THERE, I CAME BACK INTO TOWN AND TOOK MY BACKPACK FROM MY BOYFRIEND. I CHECKED MY BACKPACK TO SEE IF MY CASH WAS STILL IN THERE, AND IT WAS, BUT THE ZIPPER INSIDE MY BACKPACK THAT HAD THE CASH IN IT WAS OPENED. I THOUGHT THAT WAS ODD BUT DIDN'T THINK MUCH OF IT. 2 DAYS LATER I TOOK MY CASH TO MY BANK TO DEPOSIT IT AND ONLY HAD \$731. MY BACKPACK HAD NOT BEEN OUT OF MY SIGHT SINCE I GOT IT BACK FROM THE SALON, AND THE MONEY WENT MISSING AT SOME POINT WHILE I LEFT IT AT THE LOFT SALON.

VICTIM INTERVIEW- K.Unwa G.Unwarrant

I called the victim, K.Unwa G.Unwarrant, and spoke to her on the phone. K.Unwa explained that they originally called in (related incident 20C32998, citizen assist) asking questions about theft and charges. It was her boyfriend, J.Un D.Unwarr, that called in at the time. K.Unwa had approximately \$1200 in her backpack but was not sure on the exact amount. Since the original citizen assist, they attempted themselves to resolve this issue by speaking with everyone present at the time at the hair salon. K.Unwa said that while she was getting her hair done, the hairdresser, Christina Luck and two assistants were present. She identified the two assistants as K.Unwa (possible last name of Hastings) and Hattie (unknown last name). K.Unwa has since spoken with all three people: Christina, K.Unwa and Hattie, and all have denied knowing anything about her missing money. Since she has spoken to all three and they all denied knowing anything, she wished to file a report and pursue criminal charges. I asked her for her best estimate at the amount of stolen money, and she said around \$500.00.

I called Christina Luck and left a voicemail.

08/20/2020

CHRISTINA LUCK INTERVIEW

I spoke to Christina Luck on the phone. She confirmed that K.Unwa G.Unwarrant had a hair appointment with her on 08/04/2020 and left her backpack, which her boyfriend later retrieved. When K.Unwa G.Unwarrant's boyfriend retrieved the backpack it did not appear as though it had been tampered with and it was located in one of the salon chairs. She said K.Unwa G.Unwarrant had a secondary appointment on 08/06/2020 and she spoke about feeling relieved to have gotten her backpack back, but had not mentioned anything about missing any money. Later that evening on 08/06/2020 Christina communicated with K.Unwa G.Unwarrant and learned that some money had been missing out of her backpack. Christina did not notice anyone come into the Salon and possibly steal anything. Christina had two assistants working that day: Hattie Nall and Kylee Light.

K.Unwa G.Unwarrant INTERVIEW

I spoke to K.Unwa G.Unwarrant on the phone again. She confirmed that she realized the money was missing from her backpack the evening after her second appointment. She said her boyfriend J.Un D.Unwarr picked up her backpack from the salon and it was in a chair when he picked it up. The employees told J.Un that they didn't even see it there. K.Unwa G.Unwarrant does not remember placing it in a chair, and last remembered putting it on the floor at her feet. After J.Un picked up the backpack and she had it back, it had been about 20 minutes. K.Unwa G.Unwarrant remembered counting the money that was in her backpack the evening (Aug. 3) before her first appointment and had direct possession of it until she went to the salon. G.Unwarrant remembers another client coming in directly after her and assumed the same client was likely there by the time the backpack was picked up.

J.Un D.Unwarr INTERVIEW

I spoke to J.Un D.Unwarr on the phone. J.Unw said he went to pick up the backpack at the salon and saw two girls in the back and no one in the front. He believed the two girls there was the owner and another employee. As he walked in one of them approached him and he told her he was trying to find a backpack and saw it sitting in a salon chair. Once he got it his girlfriend asked him if the money was still there and he told her it was. He got the backpack back to her about 30 minutes later. He said he felt it was most likely the money went missing while at the salon.

Hattie Nall, Kylee Light and the possible other client have not yet been contacted.

09/10/2020

I left a voicemail for Christina Luck requesting contact numbers for the other two employees who were working at the time the backpack was left at the salon.

09/15/2020

I listened to a voicemail I received from Hattie Nall providing her phone number along with Kylee's.

09/17/2020

I called Hattie Nall and spoke to her on the phone. She was extremely professional and cooperative. She said she remembered the client with the backpack but did not know the backpack had been left in the business until the client's boyfriend came by to pick it up. She said he found the backpack in one of the chairs and believed it to be the third chair close to a little bar area. She did not see anyone take anything out of it or have any knowledge of that. I believe Nall was being upfront and truthful with me. I recorded the phone conversation and uploaded it to VIPER.

I called Kylee at [REDACTED] and I was unable to leave a voicemail as the mailbox was full.

Having exhausted all reasonable efforts to locate any further suspect information, I am inactivating this case.
