Jordan stopped her for driving with an expired registration. McMichael admitted to taking Hydrocodone and cough syrup. McMichael was cited and released from PPD holding.

NARRATIVE:

On 9/4/2024 at around 1927 hours I responded to 1690 SE Harvest Dr; Walmart to assist Deputy Jordan on a traffic stop. He told me that he had stopped Molly M. McMichael (DOB 12/29/1980) for driving with an expired vehicle registration. McMichael was driving James Macki's 2006 Chevy 1500 truck (D35176B/WA). The registration had expired 7/11/2024.

Jordan told me that he believed McMichael was under the influence of drugs. Jordan described McMichael as having exaggerated movements, pinpoint pupils and missing teeth. Jordan told me that McMichael was clenching her jaw repeatedly and sweating.

Deputy Alcantar was speaking with McMichael and as she exited the vehicle I noticed her movements were jerky and uncontrolled. Deputy Alcantar told me that McMichael had admitted to taking a pain pill.

I contacted McMichael in front of the vehicle. I noticed McMichael had rapid, jerky hand movements and would shove her hand into her front jeans pocket to try to still the movement. I noticed McMichael's speech was rapid, and that she would trail off or switch topics before finishing a sentence or train of thought.

McMichael told me that she had taken a 10 mg Hydrocodone pain pill, but could not remember when she had done so. I noticed that McMichael was clenching her jaw and sniffing frequently. I asked McMichael if she was willing to perform some voluntary field sobriety tests and she agreed to do so, but noted that she had medical conditions (fibromyalgia, arthritis) that prevented her from balancing. I performed these tests in a flat, level parking lot during daylight hours. McMichael told me that she was wearing her contacts.

I instructed McMichael how to perform the horizontal gaze nystagmus test. I noted no nystagmus during the test. During the test McMichael swayed and twitched her hands constantly. McMichael followed my pen with her head and had to be reminded to hold her head still.

I instructed McMichael how to perform the modified Romberg test. McMichael completed the test at 32 seconds. McMichael was unable to stand steady for the duration of the test. McMichael swayed approximately 2 inches back to front repeatedly during the test.

At the end of these tests it was my opinion that McMichael was impaired, and exhibiting the effects of having consumed drugs. I placed McMichael under arrest for DUI. I handcuffed McMichael, advised her of her Miranda rights as well as the date/time and that she was being audio/video recorded. McMichael indicated she understood her rights. McMichael requested I move her handcuffs to the front

due to pain. I moved her handcuffs to the front and double locked them. I searched McMichael incident to arrest, placed her in the back seat of my patrol car and seatbelted her in.

I transported McMichael to PPD holding. We arrived at PPD at 1945 hours.

McMichael remained in handcuffs in holding. I read McMichael her Miranda rights at 1956 hours. McMichael said "yes" acknowledging she would waive her rights and speak with me. I read to McMichael the Implied Consent Warning for breath. She agreed to submit to a breath test. I checked McMichael's mouth at 2000 and did not locate and foreign substances. I noted that nearly all of McMichael's teeth were removed or broken/ground down.

While waiting for the Draeger Alcotest 9510's waiting period to expire, I went through the DUI interview portion of the report with McMichael. McMichael told me that she has nerve damage in both arms. McMichael told me that the Hydrocodone she had taken was prescription, but admitted her doctor retired awhile ago and she had yet to find a new one. McMichael admitted the hydrocodone she had taken was "left over" from her valid prescription. McMichael told me that she had taken 1 or 2 Sudafed pills that morning, but told me she was not currently sick or injured. McMichael was unsure what time it was, what day it was (she eventually correctly told me it was Wednesday), or today's date. McMichael told me she had not slept the night prior. McMichael told me she had been arrested for DUI once before, by Deputy Jordan about 15 months prior. Deputy Jordan told me he was still waiting on blood results from that DUI.

Based on the extended wait times for blood results and the current recommendation from the prosecutor, I did not request a warrant for McMichael's blood.

While I was speaking with McMichael I noted she had frequent mood swings, and would rapidly switch from being cooperative and friendly to upset and tearful. McMichael was wearing untied shoes with her feet slipped into them, on top of the heel portion of the shoe. McMichael's speech was fast throughout the interaction and her words often slurred together or trailed off.

I requested records contact Ofc. Lambley for a DRE evaluation.

The Draeger Alcotest 9510 machine printed a copy of McMichael's breath test results. The IR and EC results were .000 at 2020 hours and 2025 hours. I provided McMichael a copy of the DUI hearing form, as well as her breath test results. I gave McMichael the District court notice to appear form. She signed the form and I gave her a copy.

I issued McMichael criminal citation # 4A0728240 for RCW 46.61.502, DUI.

McMichael was later released from holding by a graveyard officer.

Case closed.

1. LOCATION: I attempted to conduct this Drug Influence Evaluation in the Pullman Police Department holding facility where the floor was flat and level and there was lighting from above.

2. WITNESSES: There were no witnesses.

3. BREATH ALCOHOL TEST: I was advised that McMichael had submitted to the Draeger and her result was .000 at 2020 and 2025 hours.

4. THE NOTIFICATION & INTERVIEW OF THE ARRESTING OFFICER:

On 09/04/2024, I was off duty when I received a call at approximately 2010 hours and was advised by Records Specialist Rice that Officer Carpenter was requesting a DRE respond for DUI she had arrested. I spoke with Officer Carpenter and Sgt. Jordan who explained Sgt. Jordan had stopped McMichael for expired tabs and noticed McMichael had exaggerated movements and pinpoint pupils. Officer Carpenter advised me she attempted testing McMichael who claimed to have numerous medical conditions including Fibromyalgia, nerve damage, and dyslexia. Officer Carpenter attempted to administer the HGN but McMichael had difficulty

following instructions. Officer Carpenter told me she administered the Modified Romberg Balance test which McMichael did not seem to have any issues with. Officer Carpenter advised that McMichael clearly appeared to be under the influence of stimulants

5. INITIAL OBSERVATION OF SUSPECT:

I saw McMichael in a holding cell and noticed she was bent over at the waist most of the time that she was in the cell in what appeared to be a very exaggerated position. I requested McMichael exit the cell and advised her that I was audio and video recording. I provided McMichael with the date and time and read her her constitutional rights. McMichael said she understood her rights but when I asked if she was willing to speak to me, McMichael told me she wasn't sure what she should do.

6. MEDICAL PROBLEMS & TREATMENT:

I requested to know more about McMichael's medical conditions and McMichael advised me that she currently had stomach pain from what she referred to as a MS hug. McMichael advised that she had taken a pain pill in the afternoon but she had taken the pain pills for years. She said that she had Rheumatoid Arthritis, Fibromyalgia, a condition with her shoulders in which her chest was too big causing her shoulders to not get enough blood flow. McMichael said she had PTSD,

insomnia, and began explaining that her husband had been murdered in Moscow and that she was a Door dash driver that was going to be testifying in the Moscow murder trial. McMichael said her pain pill that she took was hydrocodone and she took it sometime in the afternoon.

I asked McMichael if she could tell me what time it was. She told me she had no idea. McMichael said she didn't know the date but she did know it was a Wednesday and told me she had a can of soup and didn't eat much. McMichael said she got most of her calories from drinking and described getting a blended Frappuccino type drink from the Daily Grind, drinking three Dr. Peppers as well as five bottles of water. McMichael said she had a tough time sleeping and she hasn't slept since the night before last. McMichael said that she was not injured but she did have Fibromyalgia and Rheumatoid Arthritis, PTSD, insomnia, depression, and bipolar disorder. McMichael denied being diabetic, denied taking insulin and denied being epileptic. I asked if she had any physical impairments and she said that she limps and her arms had a hard time. McMichael said that she had been under the care of a Nurse Practitioner, Sandy Shortzman, out of Palouse. McMichael, when questioned about stimulant use, told me she had taken cold medicine this morning and specifically had taken Sudafed.

7. DRE'S OPINION:

The entire time I was talking with McMichael, she remained bent over at the waist and would not bring her head up or make eye contact with me. When I requested that she do so, she said she could not due to her PTSD and other mental health issues. I requested to take McMichael's pulse and felt that her pulse was 94 beats per minute at 2110 hours. McMichael had muscle tremors and was consistently moving. McMichael's speech was mumbled and difficult to

understand at times. When I requested to know if McMichael was willing to participate in the Drug Influence Evaluation, she would not give me an answer and given her refusal to look at me, I did not believe I was going to be able to conduct some of the components of the Drug Influence Evaluation. McMichael did not appear safe to operate a motor vehicle. I learned this was McMichael's second arrest for DUI and the first arrest was pending drug test results. I submitted a request to the Idaho Transportation Department requesting McMichael's driver's license be reevaluated by Idaho.
